PRESS RELEASE PARTOUCHE AWARD FOR **EXPERIMENTAL SHORT FILM**

On June 20 and 21, 2008, the organizers of the Second Biennial of Contemporary Art in Le Havre, will inaugurate the Partouche Award for Experimental Short Film. This new event presents young artists—some fresh out of art or film schools, others having already shown their work in galleries and official competitions—, and intends to broaden exposure to a lesserknown genre, to strange and fascinating works.

Held in Le Havre, the official competition will present some twenty mostly European works at the Le Studio cinema. The first Partouche Award will be given by a jury of players from both the film and contemporary art scenes. The experience is intended to cross the two perspectives, from worlds that attract yet maintain a complex rapport.
